



## High Adventure Program Scholarship

The Sasquesahanough Lodge High Adventure Program Scholarship was created in hopes to provide monetary support to Arrowmen within the Lodge by paying a scholarship to one of the Order of the Arrow High Adventure Programs at Philmont Scout Ranch, The Summit Bechtel Reserve, Northern Tier, Canadian Odyssey and the Florida Sea Base.

It is the purpose of the Lodge to provide for the Arrowmen of Sasquesahanough Lodge in hopes to enlighten their Order of the Arrow experience through participation in one of these programs. All programs are the epitome of what the OA represents. Brotherhood, Cheerfulness, and Service. It is for this reason that Sasquesahanough Lodge and its leadership find it so imperative to not only support these programs but to also offer financial assistance to our Youth Arrowmen.

Although it is not a requirement to be an active member in the Order of the Arrow to participate in any of the OA High Adventure Programs, the Lodge High Adventure Scholarship is reserved for those individuals who exhibit interest and service as well as a future commitment to the Order of the Arrow. It is expected of the recipients to continue their service in the OA as well as bring their enthusiasm gained from these programs back to their home councils, lodges, chapters, and units. Each recipient will be required at the end of their experience to provide the Lodge with an account of their experiences that can be posted on the Lodge website for recognition and promotion for the programs and the scholarship.

The Scholarship may pay up to the amount of the program fee for the program the member is attending. This varies for each program, please refer to <a href="http://adventure.oa-bsa.org/">http://adventure.oa-bsa.org/</a>. The member is responsible for all other expenses, including travel costs.

Requirements to be considered for the OAHA Scholarship:

- 1. Must have attended at least two lodge functions in the previous or current year.
- 2. Must be either a brotherhood or vigil member.
- 3. Must be in good standing with the Lodge.
- 4. Must be a member of a lodge committee, team, or be a lodge or chapter officer.
- 5. Must meet OAHA guidelines & qualifications.

Once application is complete please mail no later than **March 1** of the current year of application.

Applicants will be notified of their selection no later than **April 1** of the current year that applicant has applied.
