## Scholarship Program

Each year the Sasquesahanough Lodge awards scholarships to Arrowmen interested in attending any of the following programs:

- OA High Adventure (OAHA)
  - o Canadian Odyssey Northern Tier National High Adventure Bases, Minnesota/Ontario
  - o Wilderness Voyage Northern Tier National High Adventure Bases, Minnesota
  - o Ocean Adventure Florida Sea Base, Florida Keys
  - o Summit Experience Bechtel Summit Reserve, West Virginia
  - o Trail Crew Philmont Scout Ranch, New Mexico
- National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT)
- National Order of the Arrow Conference (NOAC)

The Lodge hopes to enlighten their Order of the Arrow experience through participation in one of these programs. Although it is not a requirement to be an active member in the Order of the Arrow to participate in any of the programs, the Lodge Scholarship Program is reserved for those individuals who exhibit interest and service as well as a future commitment to the Order of the Arrow. It is expected of the recipients to continue their service in the OA as well as bring their enthusiasm gained from these programs back to their home councils, lodges, chapters, and units. Each recipient will be required at the end of their experience to provide the Lodge with an account of their experiences that can be posted on the Lodge website for recognition and promotion for the programs and the scholarship.

The Scholarship may pay up to the amount of the program fee for the program the member is attending. This varies for each program. Information on fees for OAHA can be found at <a href="http://adventure.oa-bsa.org/">http://adventure.oa-bsa.org/</a>. The Lodge website will have information on NOAC the year prior to the event. The Council website will have information on NYLT. The member is responsible for all other expenses, including travel costs. The amount of the scholarship will vary depending on the number of scholarship applicants and the funding available each year.

Requirements to be considered for the Scholarship:

- 1. Must have attended at least two lodge functions in the previous or current year.
- 2. Must be either a brotherhood or vigil member.
- 3. Must be in good standing with the Lodge.
- 4. Must be a member of a lodge committee, team, or be a lodge or chapter officer.
- 5. Must meet program guidelines & qualifications. (Particularly applicable to OAHA.)

Please submit application no later than **February 1** of the current year of application.

Applicants will be notified of their selection no later than **March 1** of the current year that applicant has applied.
