Directions

Take I-83 to exit 39A (Lewisberry / PA 114) Make a right at the end of the ramp onto Lewisberry Road (PA-114) Turn left at traffic light at end of Lewisberry Road onto Old York Road Turn right at the Second Light onto Ross Avenue Stop at Base Gate and present your ID Proceed to the Susquehanna Club (first left)

Please use Post 1 on Ross Avenue to access the Susquehanna Club.

Entry Procedures

As per the directive of the New Cumberland Army Base, all individuals 16 years and older must have an official photo ID. Each ID will be checked against the list of names to gain access. Official ID is state ID (provided by PENNDOT), driver's license, high school ID, passport, or military ID.

Every individual must register to attain access to the Banquet Hall even if just dropping off. Drivers not staying for the event must be listed where indicated on registration form. Members and guests attending the Banquet <u>cannot</u> be dropped off or picked up at the base gate.

NO WALK IN REGISTRATIONS

You must be pre-registered to gain access to the facility.
