National Order of the Arrow Conference Conference Dates August 3–8, 2020

(Approximate Tour Dates: August 1-8)

More than 6,000 Arrowmen will travel to East Lansing, Michigan, home to the 2020 National Order of the Arrow Conference at Michigan State University. Arrowmen will participate in a 6 day conference focusing on top notch training sessions, inter-lodge competitions, ceremonial evaluations, dance competitions, cool recreational opportunities, evening shows full of theatrics and special effects, and checking out the exciting programs NOAC has to offer. At NOAC, Arrowmen will stay in University housing, eat in the dining halls, and will get to spend a week with their 6,000 new best friends.

<u>Total tour cost is anticipated to not exceed \$950 per person</u>, and the Lodge is planning fundraisers to reduce this cost. The exact reduction to be dependent on the number of participants and the success of the fundraisers. Scholarships may also be available. As a point of comparison, we were able to keep the 2018 NOAC trip at \$800.

The tour fee will include all transportation, accommodations, meals and activities during the trip. The tour will likely include a stop in Cleveland and a visit to the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame. The final tour schedule will be determined once the number of participants has been finalized.

A \$200 deposit is required with the initial registration. This is non-refundable, but if you need to cancel it is transferable. Please register as soon as possible, as the Lodge is starting to make travel arrangements and needs to determine how many members will be attending.
